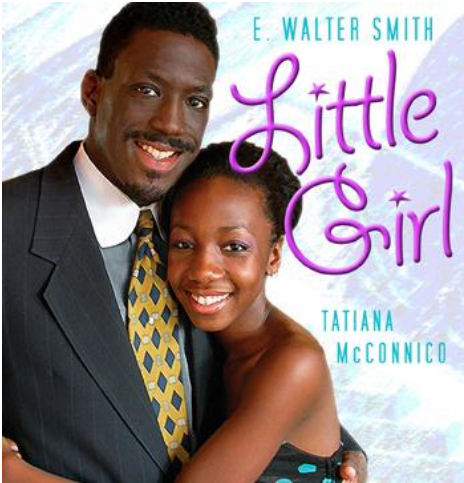


About.com's 'Best Wedding Songs' Discovers E. Walter Smith's "Little Girl"
